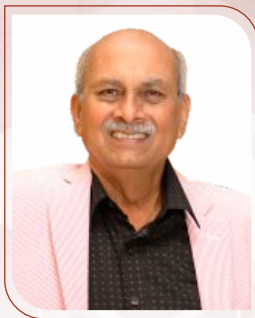
International Society for Ethnopharmacology, Switzerland

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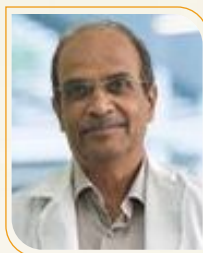
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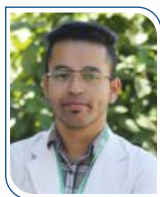

Guidelines for Abstract:

Research abstracts, broadly within the scope of the seminar's thematic areas should be submitted by e-mail as an attachment (klesfec2025@gmail.com) by December 25, 2024. The abstracts must be original and unpublished work. Abstracts must be written in English. It should include the title (14pt, bold, upper case), author(s) & affiliations, background, objective, materials and methods, results, and conclusions. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. The text should be single-spaced 12pt, Arial all through. The abstract should be submitted within 250 words in .doc/. docx file. All accepted abstracts will be published in the e-proceedings of the conference and congress.

Registration for the Congress:
